

#### **Priestly Ponderings**

So much seems to have changed in the past 2 years. Most of all I have missed our Easter celebrations, with its combination of sorrow and joy. This time is so important to us because it is all about the love our Lord Jesus showed to us selflessly. So this year we can really look forward to walking up the road to Red Hill. The 'walk of witness,' as it is known, when we stop on the way to sing that old hymn, there is a Greenhill Far Away. Reaching the natural amphitheatre we will hear Banovallum Brass playing and our service will begin. The story of Christ's trial and conviction ending in his death on the cross is told. It is an amazing experience in this place of nature and beauty, and very moving.

Before we get to Easter, though, we must work through 40 days of Lent. A time to reflect and to think about the days to come. These 40 days have biblical significance, in terms of the measurement of time. The 40 days and nights of rain that Noah experienced during the flood, for example. The Israelites wandered for 40 years after the Exodus from Egypt. Jesus spent 40 days in the desert, being tempted by the devil. So we have history behind us when we journey through Lent. A time when we try to look to improve our day to day lives. First, though, we have Shrove Tuesday when we eat all the goodies in our homes so that we can fast for the next 40 days. We make pancakes with eggs and flour and tossing them is a real art! The next day is Ash Wednesday, when traditionally palm crosses from the previous year are burnt and the ash is put on foreheads at a service. During that service we say sorry for the things we have done wrong and ask God to forgive us. This is the real beginning of Lent.

Here, in Asterby, during Lent, we will have a regular service on a Tuesday morning in Donington on Bain Church and a Lent course when we explore passages of scripture or a book each week on zoom. Holy week starts with Palm Sunday, celebrating Jesus' ride into Jerusalem on a donkey. Lent formally ends on Maundy Thursday. This is the Christian version of the Jewish 'Passover festival.' This is once more a bit of historical repetition, a reminder of when the Israelites left Egypt and painted lambs' blood on their door frames to protect them from the wrath of the Angel of Death. We Christians celebrate Jesus' last meal with his disciples on Maundy Thursday. So we return to Good Friday and then Easter Day when Jesus rose from the dead and the disciples, who saw him in the garden, were scared and amazed at his resurrection. After the preparation of the 40 days of Lent you and I may well be ready for that wonderful Easter celebration, when we recognise how much our Lord gave us, when he died upon the Cross, once for all — to rise in glory.

#### **Donington on Bain Parish Council**

The Parish Council approved the proposed budget for 2022/23 and approved the precept of £10,000. Please note there has been no increase in the precept for the past two years.

Due to lottery funding COVID projects our lottery bid to replace the playground was rejected. The Parish council continues to maintain and repair the playground to its best abilities. The repairs to the fence around the playground have recently been completed. However due to the age of the playground we expect further deterioration to the equipment and further maintenance costs in 2022/23. We have submitted a grant request to our East Lindsey Councillor for approximately £300 towards these costs.

All of the allotments have now been allocated and the majority of the allotment renewal payments had been received.

#### GOOD NEWS.

A business owner had spread some gravel on the footpath. The Clerk had written with a letter of thanks.

A councillor had made enquiries with the Tesco Community grant scheme to fund the maintenance of the playground.

The Parish Council are considering the proposal to supply a walks leaflet detailing the walks around the village. There was a possibility of funding for the walks leaflet holders via another councillor.

#### **NEWS FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL**

Mrs Christine Raynor was warmly welcomed back onto the Council.

Following complaints about an increase in dog fouling, it was agreed that the Council will provide "poo bags". These can be found by the grit bins, in the telephone box and in the bus shelter. Signs will remind dog walkers that failure to clean up after their dog can incur a £1,000 fine.

New volunteers have been recruited for the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme providing support for the north (Meadow View), mid (Church Lane) and southern (Silver Street) parts of the Village. Detailed information will be posted on the Benniworth Website.

It is hoped that the Village will hold events to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. A Village Committee is to be formed and the first meeting will be held at Moor Farm on **Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March, at 7.30pm.** If you missed this meeting and would like to get involved, please contact the Parish Clerk.
